#### **Community relations:**

- Meeting with Piper Huggins: Jane Everett, Hélène and I met with Ms. Huggins. We discussed obtaining financing from the city for various community development initiatives in Milton-Park.

#### **External affairs:**

- TaCEQ meeting on February 12<sup>th</sup>: We continued to discuss a plan of action for the upcoming months in relation to the student strike.
- Met with Mariève (PGSS VP External). We discussed possibilities for common mobilization at McGill against the tuition fee increases.

#### **Mobilization and campus affairs:**

- Student strike in full swing: As of writing, 70 000 students had a strike mandate or were on strike across Quebec. This is becoming the major social issue of the month, if not the year. Upcoming demonstrations include one taking place on March 22<sup>nd</sup> in Montreal as well as multiple other demonstrations planned virtually every week during the strike. - Bus to Quebec City for March 1<sup>st</sup> demonstration: I booked a bus to Quebec City. Total cost was 1019.39\$.
- EdUS town hall on student strike and education programs: I attended this assembly and talked about the strike movement in Quebec.
